Fees: Tardy Turtle £10 per cat, per day, if payment not received 14 days after entry or before closing date, whichever is sooner.

Alternative payment arrangements must be made in writing with the show manager to avoid these fees.

No entry fee or related charge will be returned except for failure on the part of the sponsoring club to hold the show as advertised..." This includes place holders.

Confirmations: It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to check the confirmation slips issued, please check carefully. If you do not receive a confirmation email before the closing date, please contact the entry clerk.

Benching: The club will provide a double space (4ft x 2ft) per 1st & 3rd cats entered, e.g 1 cat = 1 double space, 2 cats = 1 double space, 3 cats = 2 double spaces. Only cats from the same household may share unless separate pens are specified with entry, which will incur extra fees. Benching will be traditional rows. Requests for benching preferences should be submitted at time of entry, no guarantee can be given of meeting all benching requests, but, we will do our best. This is a bring your own pen show, exhibitors will need to provide a suitable pen, such as a Sturdi pen, or similar. There will be a limited number of metal pens available for hire at extra cost.

Show times: Checking in from 8am to 9.15am, both days.

Judging will start at 9.30am, until all judging completed, including congresses.

Open to the public from 10am to 4pm and, in consideration of paying spectators, no cats may be removed from the show hall before 4pm without the show manager's permission.

Please note - we are running congresses on Saturday, these require a minimum of 20 cats to count; please do not leave if your cats are eligible to enter.

There will be NO access to the venue on Friday 15th November.

Health Requirements: This show is a NON-VETTED show. Up to date vaccination cards must be produced at check in. The show manager reserves the right to remove any cat showing any signs of illness, mites, fleas, fungal infections, etc, in accordance with TICA rules. Cats from a household where there has been an infectious disease or fungal infection within 21 days of the show must not attend.

Any pregnant or lactating cat will be disqualified. Please ensure all claws front and back are clipped, prior to judging.

Registration: In order for a cat to be shown without a registration number, that cat must be eligible for registration and competition in TICA in the class in which the cat is to be shown. No entry shall be accepted without a TICA registration number unless documentation is provided with the entry that shows the entry is eligible for registration in TICA. Such documentation includes, but is not limited to the following: **a.** TICA litter registration; **b.** TICA breeder slip; **c.** Registration certificate from any association TICA recognises; **d.** certified pedigree from any association TICA recognises; **e.** Registration certificate of both of the parents of the entry by either **c** or **d** above. Documentation must be submitted with the entry form.

Kittens: Any kitten entered must be at least 4 calendar months old but less than 8 calendar months on the date of the show. Neutered kittens are eligible for entry.

Household pets: HHP's over 8 months of age must be neutered or spayed.

Clerks: Clerks will be offered one free entry per day of clerking or £25.00 per day. Lunch will be provided. Please contact the Show Manager or Entry Clerk to express an interest.

Catering: A catering unit will be provided by Unicorn Diner for breakfasts and lunches. The club will provide tea & coffee making facilities (please bring your own mug) and, of course, cake!

Travel: nearest train station is Spalding. Taxis are always outside the station.

Travelling by car: The show will be well signposted. Enter PE11 2XH into your satnav as this will bring you directly to the venue. Car parking will also be clearly signposted.

Overseas visitors: The nearest pet-friendly airports are Heathrow, Gatwick or Manchester. Please note, the club is unable to provide any transport.

Hotels: There is no official show hotel, however, the nearest cat friendly hotel is:-
